PUBLIC NOTICE NO. 09/2020 dated 18.02.2020

Subject:- Sharing of 'load port images' of consignments of 'Metal Scrap' and 'Waste Paper' at the time of examination by the Customs Authorities.

It is to bring into the notice of all concerned that huge volume of import of 'Metal Scrap' and 'Waste Paper' is being effected through various ports of Noida Customs Commissionerate.

It may not be out of context to mention that the possibility of unlawful import of precious metals, arms and ammunition, drugs, and other goods of prohibited and restricted categories in the garb of 'Metal Scrap' and 'Waste Paper' does exist. At times, RMS alerts to that effect are being issued by Risk Management Division, DRI, and other Government agencies. In terms of Para 2.56 of Handbook of Procedures of FTP 2015-20, it is obligatory on the part of the Pre-shipment Inspection Agency to take photographs or make video of the inspection carried out, duly capturing the following activities/details, and upload the same on DGFT website through digital signatures and to email the same to psicdgft@gov.in through registered e-mail of PSIA.

- (i) Photograph(s) or video clipping of the place of inspection with PSIA inspector (mandatory) and representatives of exporter / importer, if available (optional); with time, date of the inspection;
- (ii) Photograph(s) or video clipping of the testing instrument(s) used for inspection;

- (iii) Photograph(s) or video clipping of the process of stuffing of containers showing the container number
- (iv) Photograph(s) or video clipping of the sealing process

Accordingly, to expedite the clearance of 'Metal waste cargo' as well as 'Paper waste cargo' all importers and their Customs Brokers are advised to share the images captured at the time of loading the cargo into the container at the port of loading, with the Customs Authorities at the time of examination. It would not only provide a 360° view of the import cargo and help the Customs Authorities to identify the risky cargo, but would also contribute to eliminating any possible threat to national security. This practice would help in examination of the cargo and also reduce the dwell time in examination, and thus will be a step forward towards ease of doing business.

Difficulties faced, if any, in implementation of the directions, may be brought into the notice of undersigned.
